He began working at Henderson's Furniture in 1918, at age twelve, and by the time he was eighteen he was running the factory. The factory made all sorts of

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things—kitchen tables, rattan chairs, and kindergarten sets that were very popular at Christmas, as they were often given as presents.

Whenever Mr. Henderson wanted to make a different type of chair or table, he'd bring in someone from another factory who knew how to do it, and would give orders to ordinary workers like Mr. Giguère, John Dooker, Charlie Marsh, and John himself to watch him carefully to learn the process used to construct the new wood product. When they had learned the method, Henderson would dismiss the men, because he didn't want to pay his high salary indefinitely.

On November 11, 1918, the Great War ended. When

of the family name changed to Zinnicker to Canadianize it and make it easier to gain employment. Bill began working full-time at Henderson's and was paid \$3.15 for fifty-five hours of work, ten hours a day, Monday to Friday, and five hours on Saturday morning. He gave almost all of his pay to his mother, who was struggling to feed and clothe nine children.

About 1924, when Bill was working at Henderson's, a tornado-like storm hit the area. It ripped the roof off the factory and picked up planks of wood that were piled up outside and whipped them through the windows, smashing the glass and in some cases taking out the whole window frame as well. Luckily, no one was hurt.
